

Budget Hearing  
9-16-08

The Cedar Creek Board of Trustees met at 7:00 p.m., on 9-16-08, at the Village Hall for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing to hear comments of taxpayers on the proposed budget and to adopt a budget for fiscal year 2008-2009. Advance notice of the Public Hearing was given by publication in the Plattsmouth Journal and by posting in the village. Board members present: Swenson and Olson. Pam Swenson represented Dan Muntz and Bob Ford by proxy. J.R. Olson represented Randy Moses by proxy.

No comments were made by the public in regard to the proposed budget. Motion by Olson, second by Swenson, to waive the three required readings of Ordinance 2008-01. Vote: The motion carried on an affirmative vote of 5-0. Voting yes were Swenson and Olson. Swenson voted yes on behalf of Muntz and Ford by proxy. Olson voted yes on behalf of Moses by proxy. Motion by Swenson, second by Olson, to adopt Ordinance 2008-01 termed as the Annual Appropriations Bill. Motion carried on an affirmative vote of 5-0. Voting yes were Swenson and Olson. Swenson voted yes on behalf of Muntz and Ford by proxy. Olson voted yes on behalf of Moses by proxy. Ordinance 2008-01 shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Motion by Olson, second by Swenson, to close the Budget Hearing and open the Special Hearing to request the final tax request be set at a different amount than the prior year tax request. All ayes. Roll call: Swenson present, Olson present. Pam Swenson representing Muntz and Ford by proxy. J.R. Olson representing Moses by proxy. Advance notice of the Special Hearing was given by publication in the Plattsmouth Journal and by posting in the village.

Resolution 908, introduced by Olson, second by Swenson, approving the 2 ½% restricted funds base increase and exceeding the budget by an additional 1% increase. The motion carried by an affirmative vote of 5-0. Voting yes were Swenson and Olson. Swenson voted yes on behalf of Muntz and Ford by proxy. Olson voted yes on behalf of Moses by proxy. Motion by Swenson, second by Olson, to adjourn the Special Hearing. All ayes.
