

Budget Hearing  
9-18-2012

The Cedar Creek Board of Trustees met at 7:00 p.m., on 9-18-2012, at the Village Hall for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing to hear comments of taxpayers on the proposed budget and to adopt a budget for fiscal year 2012-2013. Advance notice of the Public Hearing was given by publication in the Plattsmouth Journal and by posting in the Village. Board members present: Moses, Mohler, and McAllister. Moses represented Sharp and Pearrow by proxy. The Hearing was conducted by R. Moses, Chairman Pro Tempore.

No comments were made by the public in regard to the proposed budget. Motion by Mohler, second by McAllister to waive the three required readings of Ordinance 2012-02. The motion carried on an affirmative vote of 5-0. Voting yes were Mohler, McAllister, and Moses. Moses voted yes on behalf of Pearrow and Sharp by proxy. Motion by McAllister, second by Mohler to adopt Ordinance 2012-02 termed as the Annual Appropriations Bill. Motion carried on an affirmative vote of 5-0. Voting yes were Mohler, McAllister, Moses. Moses voted yes on behalf of Pearrow and Sharp by proxy. Ordinance 2012-02 shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting as required by law.

Motion by McAllister, second by Mohler, to close the Budget Hearing and open the Special Hearing to request the final tax request be set at a different amount than the prior year tax request. All ayes. Roll call: Mohler present, McAllister present, Moses present. Moses representing Pearrow and Sharp by proxy. Advance notice of the Special Hearing was given by publication in the Plattsmouth Journal and by posting in the village.

Resolution 912, introduced by Mohler, second by McAllister, approving the 2 ½ % restricted funds base increase and exceeding the budget by an additional 1% increase. The motion carried by an affirmative vote of 5-0. Voting yes were Mohler, McAllister, and Moses. Moses voted yes on behalf of Pearrow and Sharp by proxy. Motion by Mohler, second by McAllister to adjourn Special Hearing. All ayes.
